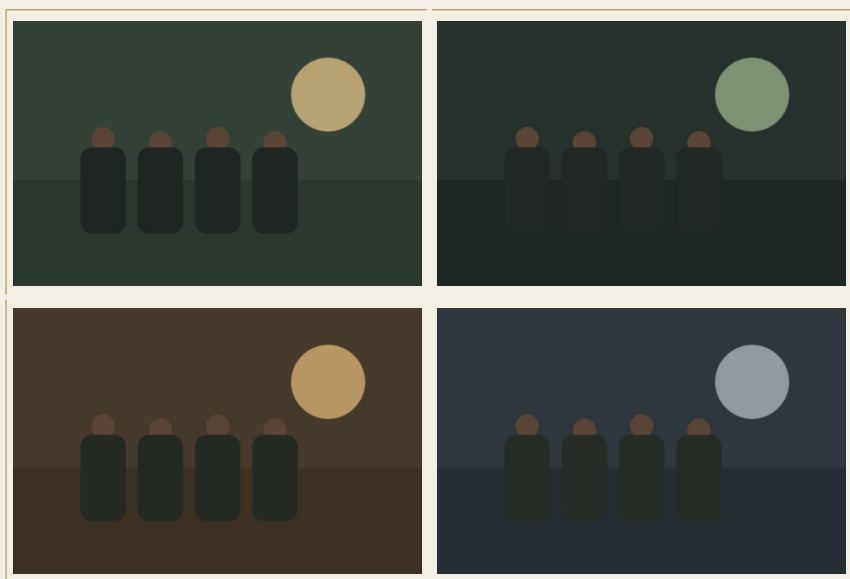
From His Church Family
